

Guidelines - Midterm Artist Slide Presentation or Paper – VIS 60

For either choice, you must thoroughly address the prompts (see Prompts for Midterm)

Slides

Turn in via USB Key (or preferred method by your TA) to your Section TA.

First slide: Your Name, Title/Artist for presentation

10 to 15 Image Slides of Artist's Work (Use jpegs or smaller files for the slides)

Last slide: Bibliography of websites, books, articles cited

Notes: Do not include too much text in your slides.

You can include "notes to read" in your slide presentation (the audience does not see the notes)

Practice your Presentation before with friends. Time your presentation to be 10 minutes.

(Between 9 minutes and 10 minutes, no more than 10 minutes)

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3 Page Paper

Print Out Your Paper. Include CD or disc with 10 -15 Images (or preferred method by your TA)

Cover Sheet: Your Name, Title/Artist for paper

Separate Inside Sheet, Your Full Name as on the Roster and Your Student ID #

Next 3 Pages: Address the prompts.

Include Bibliography after 3 pages of writing.

Note: please have someone proof read your paper before turning it in. Take time to make sure

grammar and sentence structure is correct. Take time to make an appointment at the UCSD
